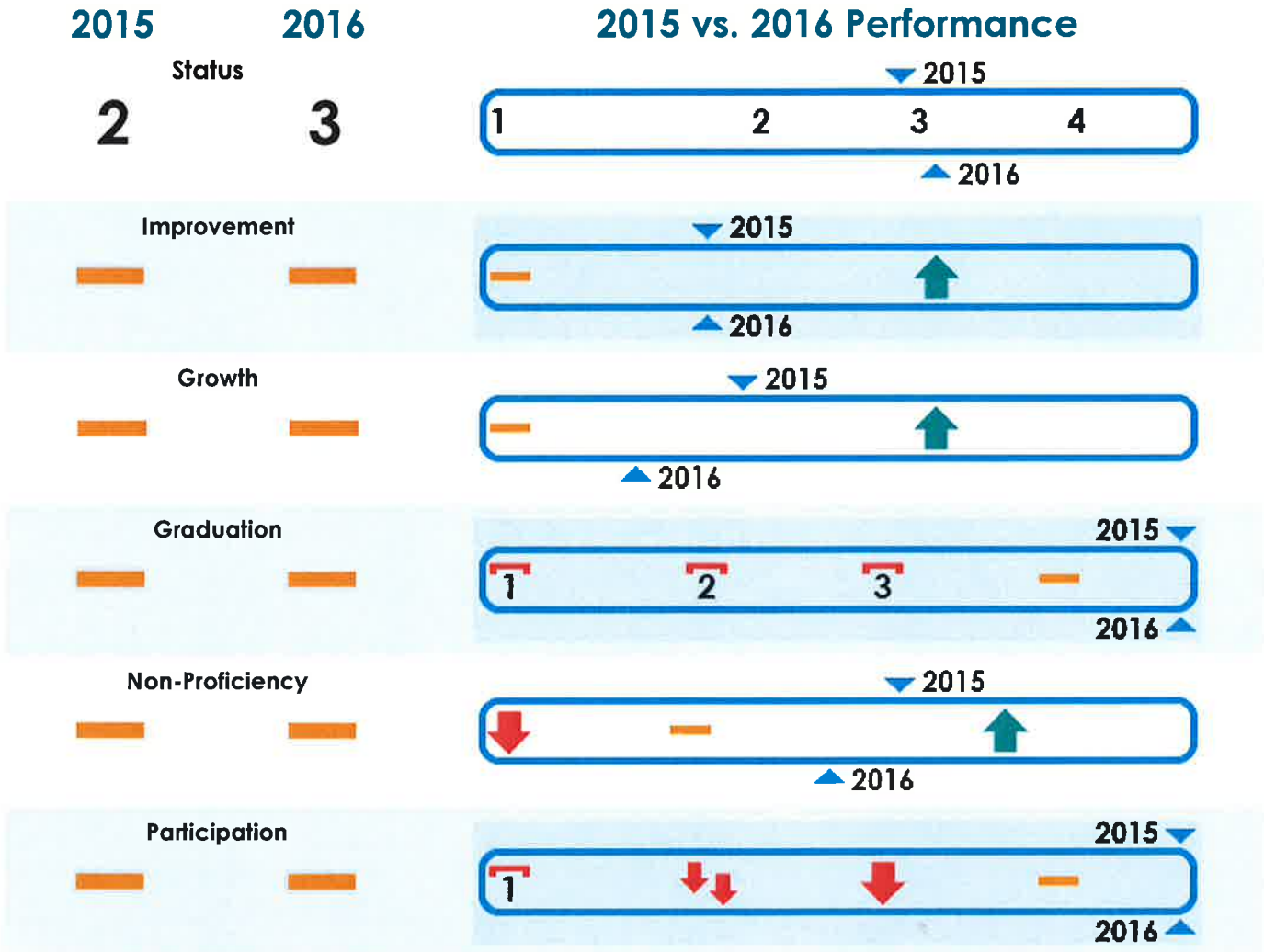

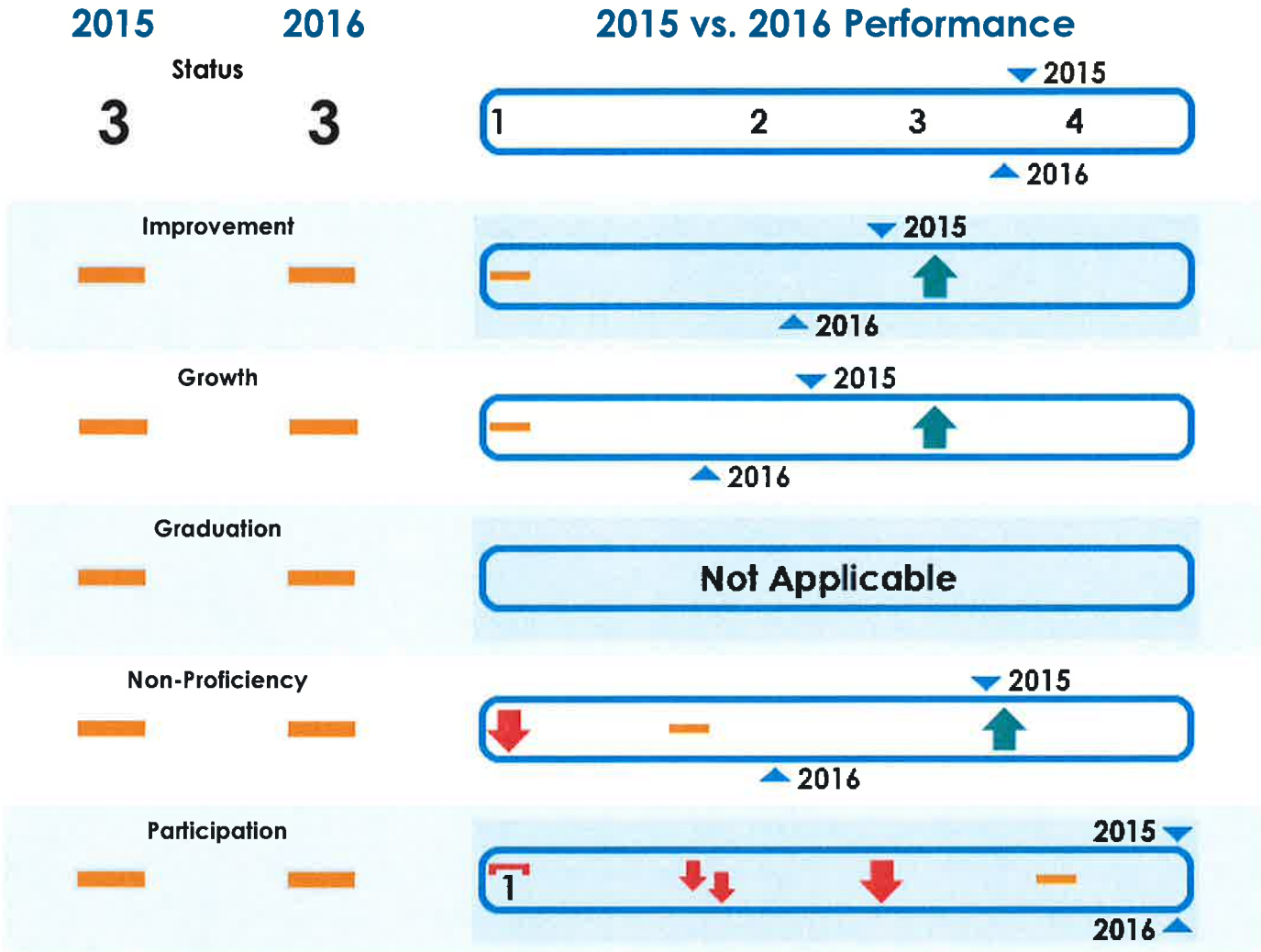

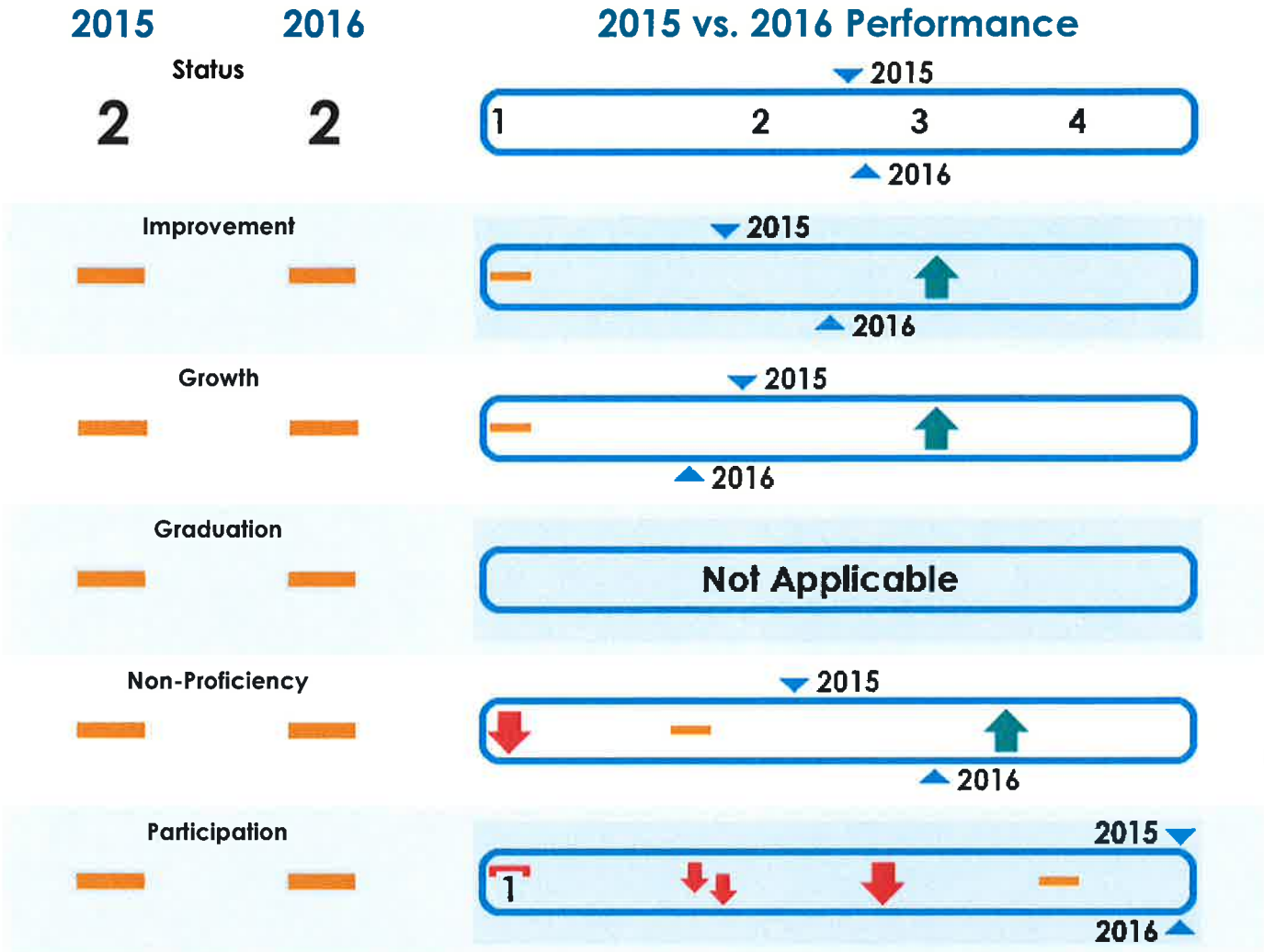

2015 Final Middle School Classification

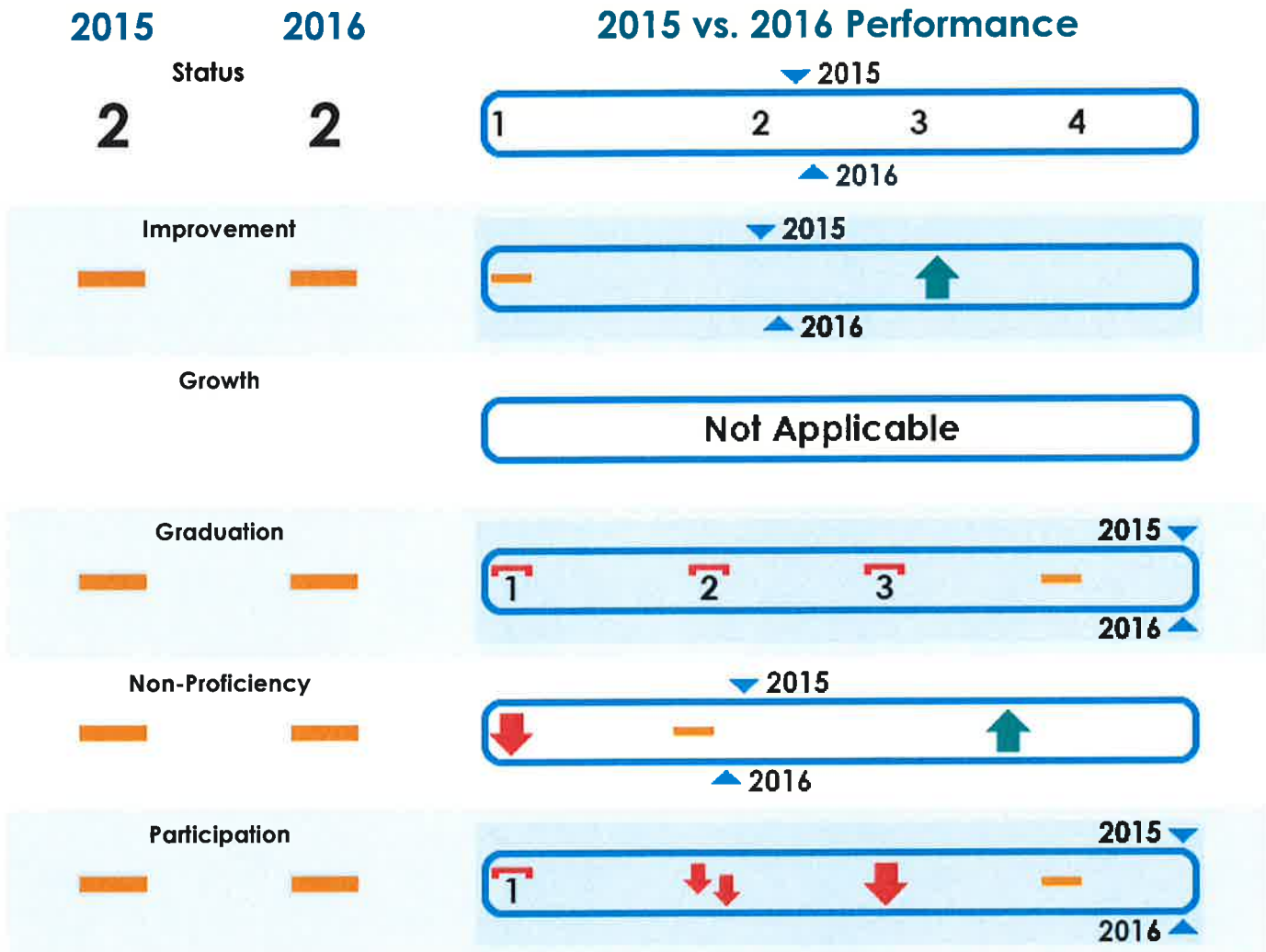
