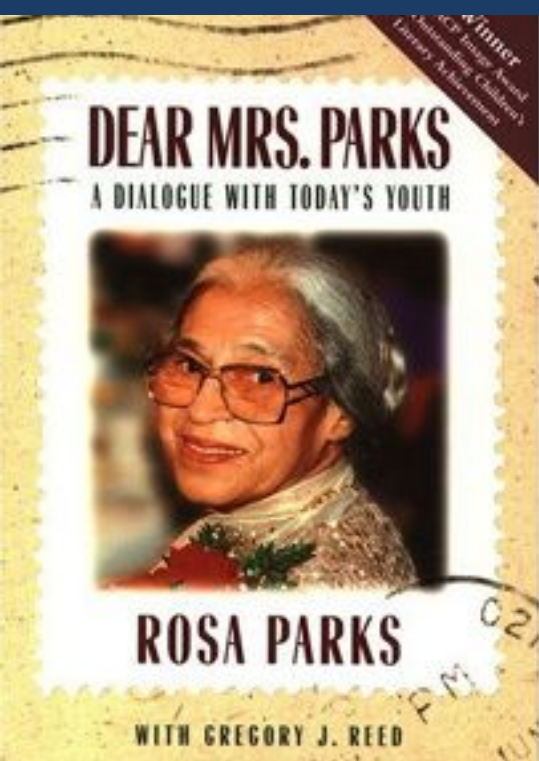


ROSA PARKS

- Parents split when she was 2

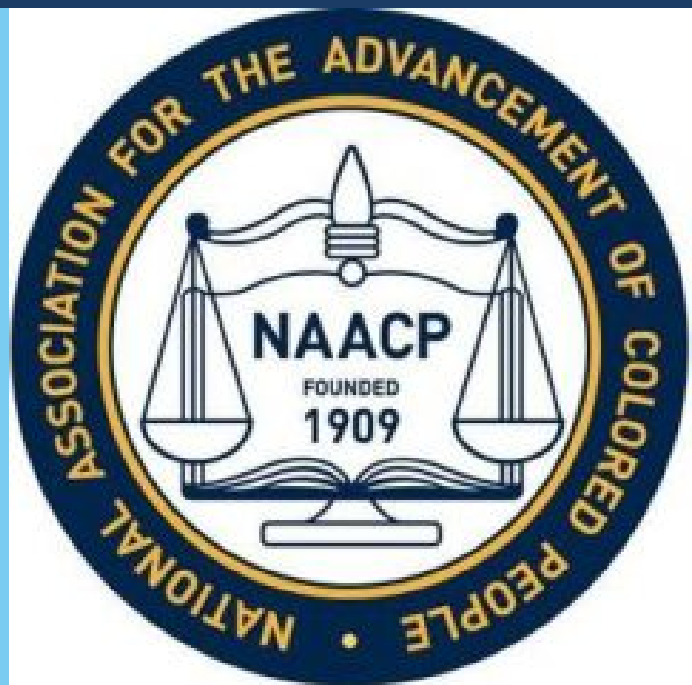


BOOKS AND TEACHING

ACTIVIST

- Joined the Montgomery chapter of the NAACP

- Married to Raymond Parks
- Died on October 24, 2005 from natural causes
- Is a Famous African-American Woman to this day
- Is remembered for refusing to give up her seat to a white person on the bus
