#### **BUDGET RESOLUTIONS**

#### 1) GENERAL FUND BUDGET

Fischer moved that the General Fund Budget for 2023-2024 be set at \$7,131,007 with a Property Tax Requirement of \$3,625,868. After some discussion, Beck seconded and motion carried 5-yes 1-absent (Matt Kruse)

#### 2) BUILDING FUND BUDGET

Lange moved that the Building Fund Budget for 2023-2024 be set at \$1,475,000 with a Property Tax Requirement of \$303,030. Baker seconded and motion carried 5-yes 1-absent (Matt Kruse)

## **RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST**

Beck moved to approve the following Property Tax Request as written in the agenda. Fischer seconded and motion carried 5-yes 1-absent (Matt Kruse)

### RESOLUTION SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST RESOLUTION NO. School Year 2023-2024

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 and 77-1633 provides that the Governing Body of Scribner-Snyder Community Schools passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of Scribner-Snyder Community Schools resolves that:

1. The 2023-2024 property tax request be set at:

General Fund: \$3,625,868.00

Special Building Fund: \$ 303,030.00

- 2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 7.64 percent.
- 3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property would be 0.71013 per \$100 of assessed value.
- 4. Scribner-Snyder Community Schools proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be 0.708037 per \$100 of assessed value.
- 5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of Scribner-Snyder Community Schools will decrease last year's budget by 1.62 percent.
  - 6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forward to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2023.
