

BUDGET RESOLUTIONS

1) GENERAL FUND BUDGET

Fischer moved that the General Fund Budget for 2023-2024 be set at \$7,131,007 with a Property Tax Requirement of \$3,625,868. After some discussion, Beck seconded and motion carried 5-yes 1-absent (Matt Kruse)

2) BUILDING FUND BUDGET

Lange moved that the Building Fund Budget for 2023-2024 be set at \$1,475,000 with a Property Tax Requirement of \$303,030. Baker seconded and motion carried 5-yes 1-absent (Matt Kruse)

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST

Beck moved to approve the following Property Tax Request as written in the agenda. Fischer seconded and motion carried 5-yes 1-absent (Matt Kruse)

RESOLUTION SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST
RESOLUTION NO. School Year 2023-2024

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 and 77-1633 provides that the Governing Body of Scribner-Snyder Community Schools passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of Scribner-Snyder Community Schools resolves that:

1. The 2023-2024 property tax request be set at:

General Fund: \$3,625,868.00
Special Building Fund: \$ 303,030.00

2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 7.64 percent.

3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property would be 0.71013 per \$100 of assessed value.

4. Scribner-Snyder Community Schools proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be 0.708037 per \$100 of assessed value.

5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of Scribner-Snyder Community Schools will decrease last year's budget by 1.62 percent.

6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forward to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2023.


Motion to Return to Regular Session
